What can you tell about Vikings from this chapter?</p> <p>Challenge: Write a letter to Gobber the Belch to ask him if you could be on the Dragon Initiation Programme.</p> <p>Please do not worry if you do not have a copy of the book to refer to pages either miss those questions out or take a chance and have a go.</p> <p><u>Word of the day</u> Flourish Remember to look for which word class it belongs to, count the syllables in the word, say the word out loud to pronounce it, write a definition and then put it in a meaningful sentence. As challenge can you find a synonym or an antonym and a pre-fix or a suffix.
